Converting Capabilities Sheet

OVERVIEW

Paper Dimensions LLC has been slitting, rewinding, and converting paper rolls for manufacturers since 1972 from our Beaver Dam, Wisconsin facility. Our five dedicated rewinder/slitters cover slit widths from 0.5" to 112" and unwind roll outside diameters up to 84". The table below summarizes the working range of each machine — final fit for your job is confirmed against your specific material, roll dimensions, and machine match during quote review.

Machine 63 can trim as wide as 61" with 3" chucks and 62" with 4" chucks.
Trim minimums are 1/4" to 1/2".
Unwind core sizes are 3", 4", 6", 8", 10", and 12" on all machines, plus 16" on the Webco.
Rewind core sizes are 1", 2", 3", and 6" on the Jennerjahns, and 3", 4", 5", 6", 8", 10", and 12" on all other machines.
Standard tolerances are ±1/32" on widths, ±1% on lengths, and ±1/2" on outside diameters.

PACKAGING

Packaging is configured to the specification of each job — we do not run a fixed standard packaging program. Available options include:

- Cradle packaging
- Individually wrapped rolls
- Blind shipment with your branding
- Custom labeling
